1. RHYMETIME FOR BABIES AND TODDLERS

First session: Thursday 23RD April at 10:30am

Then at 10:30am every Tuesday and Thursday morning during lockdown

"Singing with Gilbert" is a series of online nursery and action rhyme sessions aimed at pre-school age children (babies and toddlers) lasting for about 15 to 20mins.

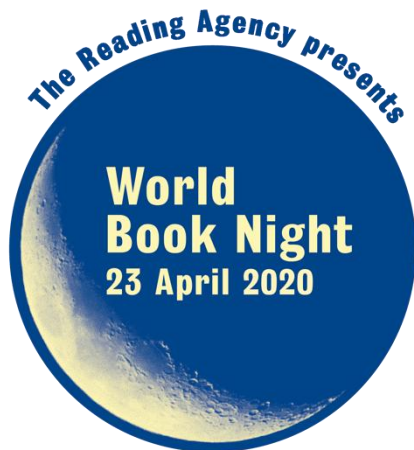
number and age of the children who will be with you. If you'd be happy to give us your children's names they might be greeted personally during the session!
