As a Trustee for Northfields Community Library Angela will take the lead on income generation but she is also keen to contribute generally to the day-to-day work of the library, volunteering and completing training as required, as well as playing a full part on the Board.

We are delighted that Angela will be joining us. Her experience will bring great benefits to our library as it continues to develop.

NORTHFIELDS LIBRARY COVID UPDATE

In view of the current high numbers of Covid infections we have decided that for the safety of our volunteers and customers we will continue with some restrictions in terms of library use. We will keep these under review but for the time being we will ask customers to:

- Use the NHS QR code to register when you come into the library. Don't worry if you don't have the app but you will need to give your name and contact details to one of our volunteers (this information is only kept for 21 days)
- Hands - Use the hand sanitiser on entry
- Face - Wear a mask (unless you are exempt). Our volunteers will be wearing face masks.
- Space - Follow the one way system and maintain a social distance of 2 metres from people who are not in your household
- A maximum number of 15 people are allowed in the Library so please be patient if you have to wait or if we ask you to move on to allow others to come in.
- We will be offering 45 min bookable slots to use the public computers.
- At the moment we do not have the space to allow people to sit and study but hope to introduce this in the Autumn.

We will update this information here in the newsletter and also on our website so please check to see what new activities we are introducing.

The Library is run by local volunteers so please respect us, and keep yourselves and others safe, by following our guidance. Thank you and we look forward to seeing you in the library.

LATERAL FLOW TEST KITS AVAILABLE IN THE LIBRARY FOR CUSTOMERS

Now that council run libraries are no longer operating as a vaccination centre, all Ealing Libraries have been asked to keep stocks of lateral flow test kits to hand out on request. Northfields Library will be holding these kits.

One in three people with COVID-19 do not display any symptoms and this can mean that the virus is spread to other people, including people you live with.

Residents are encouraged to pick up rapid tests and do them twice a week to make sure that they are not carrying COVID-19 without displaying symptoms.
