



My daily inspiration is the green-ness of nature and the eyes of creatures we share the planet with, especially our closest mammal relatives, apes and monkeys.



NEED HELP WITH CLOTHES REPAIR? LEARN HOW TO STITCH AND MEND








Co-author Lindsay Swan will talk about her book "Accidental Lives".


GILBERT IS SAYING GOODBYE!

What is it like to volunteer?

Tom Roland has just completed a very successful Silver Volunteering placement. He writes:

"Northfields Library is a great place to volunteer for DofE. At the library you will have a few roles: cataloguing and scanning in books; shelving and general organisation; helping to set up displays in the library windows and helping customers with their problems. As well as obvious skills like scanning barcodes it will help develop a wide range of soft skills: communication, team working and problem solving just to name a few.

As well as the day to day – scanning and shelving etc you will likely want to spend some of your hours helping with wider activities in the library. I, for example, helped out with the annual Plant Sale – helping to put up posters, set up the stall and clearing back up. Another idea might be helping out with, or even setting up holiday clubs for kids.

Whether cataloguing a library collection or handing posters out around Northfields, I learned that small acts of service make a big difference. I hope future DofE students will embrace the variety of volunteering opportunities available – and get as much out of it as possible."

Everyone enjoyed Teresa's Chair Yoga session at the Monday Social and really felt the benefit – thank you Teresa!




