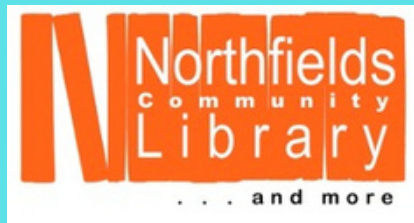

Northfields Community Library is run by an independent charity and staffed entirely by volunteers, and this sale is one of our main sources of funding to keep the local library open for you.

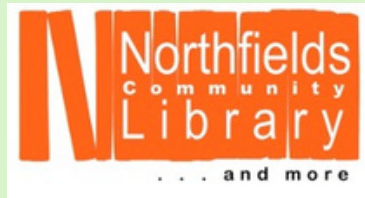
